Now that the weather has improved can you please send children to school with sun cream on and a labelled hat on those sunny days!

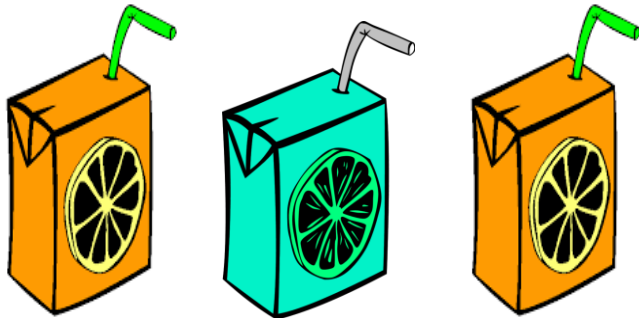




Summer is here
